A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
6 purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of
8 the State Appellate Defender:

9	For Personal Services	17,007,600
10	For State Contributions to Social Security	1,300,500
11	For Contractual Services	2,658,000
12	For Travel	35,000
13	For Commodities	27,000
14	For Printing	28,000
15	For Equipment	28,000
16	For EDP	1,091,700
17	For Telecommunications	<u>85,000</u>
18	Total	\$22,260,800

19 Section 10. The amount of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Appellate
21 Defender Federal Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate
22 Defender for expenses related to federally assisted programs

1 to work on systemic sentencing issues appeals cases to which
2 the agency is appointed and provide public defenders in rural
3 counties the resources needed to adequately investigate and
4 defend indigent clients.

5 Section 15. The amount of \$120,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary
8 and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

9 Section 20. The amount \$70,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
11 the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide
12 training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training
13 Program.

14 Section 25. The amount of \$305,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
16 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a
17 Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

18 Section 30. The amount of \$65,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
20 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Law
21 Student Intern Program.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
2 1, 2018.
