

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board
9 for ordinary and contingent expenses:

10	For Personal Services	1,182,000
11	For State Contributions to Social	
12	Security, for Medicare	16,300
13	For Contractual Services	300,000
14	For Travel	39,500
15	For Commodities	5,000
16	For Printing	6,000
17	For Equipment	4,000

1 Section 10. The sum of \$980,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
4 with administering GED tests.

5 Section 15. The sum of \$6,950,800, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
8 associated with the Re-enrollment Student Program and adult
9 education services.

10 Section 20. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and
13 Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered
14 Nurse Preparation.

15 Section 25. The sum of \$61,600, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding
18 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's
19 Challenge Program.

20 Section 30. The sum of \$14,079,000, or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City
2 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

3 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
5 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community
6 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community
7 colleges for the purposes specified:

8	Small College Grants	550,000
9	Retirees Health Insurance Grants	0
10	Workforce Development Grants	0
11	Performance Funding Grants	<u>360,000</u>

13 Section 40. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
16 associated with the development, support or administration of
17 the Illinois Longitudinal Data System.

18 Section 45. The sum of \$1,491,500, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
20 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to
21 operate an educational facility in the former community
22 college district #541 in East St. Louis.

1 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much
 2 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
 3 Community College Board for all costs associated with career
 4 and technical education activities:

8 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much of

18 Section 60. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
 19 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
 20 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College
 21 Board for distribution to qualifying public community
 22 colleges for the purposes specified:

23 Base Operating Grants191,271,900
 24 Equalization Grants75,570,800

1 Section 85. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult
 3 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
 4 operational expenses associated with administration of adult
 5 education and literacy activities.

6 Section 90. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 8 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for a grant to
 9 Rock Valley College for programs for transitioning high
 10 school students.

 12 Section 95. The sum of \$1,215,500, or so much thereof as
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 14 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse the
 15 following colleges for costs associated with the Illinois
 16 Veterans' Grant:
