

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
7 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General
8 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
9 the Judicial Inquiry Board:

1 to which the agency is appointed.

2 Section 15. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for
5 expenses related to federally assisted programs to work on
6 systemic sentencing issues appeals cases to which the agency
7 is appointed.

8 Section 20. The amount of \$175,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
10 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the
11 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

12 Section 25. The amount of \$63,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
14 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide
15 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public
16 Defender Training Program.
