A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. In addition to any other sums appropriated,
6 the sum of \$272,827,400, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is appropriated from the Title III Social Security
8 and Employment Fund to the Department of Employment Security
9 for operational expenses, awards, grants, and permanent
10 improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.

11 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of
