2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6147, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. In addition to any other sums appropriated,
7 the sum of \$272,827,400, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is appropriated from the Title III Social Security
9 and Employment Fund to the Department of Employment Security
10 for operational expenses, awards, grants, and permanent
11 improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.
