SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to various State agencies and the Office of the Governor for specified purposes. Amends Public Act 99-491 by changing the amounts of certain appropriations. Makes a reappropriation from the Capital Development Fund to the Capital Development Board. If and only if Senate Bill 2038 of the 99th General Assembly becomes law, repeals a provision in Senate Bill 2038 limiting the appropriation authority granted in that bill. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The amount of \$36,000,000, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Garage
7 Revolving Fund to the Department of Central Management
8 Services to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
9 Department of Central Management Services, not including
10 personal services.

11 Section 5. The amount of \$30,000,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statistical
13 Services Revolving Fund to the Department of Central
14 Management Services to meet the ordinary and contingent
15 expenses of the Department of Central Management Services,
16 not including personal services.

17 ARTICLE 2

18 Section 1. "An Act concerning appropriations", Public
19 Act 99-491, approved December 7, 2015, is amended by changing

1 Section 10 of Article 2 as follows:

2 (P.A. 99-491, Art. 2, Sec. 10)

3 Sec. 10. The sum of \$37,000,000 ~~\$25,500,000~~, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
5 Department of Corrections Reimbursement and Education Fund to
6 the Department of Corrections for payment of expenses
7 associated with miscellaneous programs, including, but not
8 limited to, prior year costs, medical costs, food
9 expenditures and various construction costs.

11 ARTICLE 3

12 Section 1. The amount of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of
14 Corrections Reimbursement and Education Fund to the
15 Department of Corrections for payment of expenses associated
16 with federal programs, including, but not limited to,
17 construction of additional beds, treatment programs, and
18 juvenile supervision.

19 Section 5. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Working Capital
21 Revolving Fund to the Department of Corrections for ordinary

1 and contingent expenses, but not including personal services.

2 Section 10. The amount of \$150,000,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Budget
4 Stabilization Fund to the Department of Corrections for
5 ordinary and contingent expenses, but not including personal
6 services.

7 ARTICLE 4

8 Section 1. The sum of \$25,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Human
10 Services from the Budget Stabilization Fund for operational
11 expenses, but not including personal services.

12 ARTICLE 5

13 Section 1. The amount of \$100,000,000, or so much
14 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Budget
15 Stabilization Fund to the Office of the Governor to be
16 directed to the state agencies to be expended, in the
17 discretion of and as determined by the Governor upon written
18 direction of the Governor to the Comptroller, for operational
19 expenses, but not including personal services.

1 ARTICLE 6

2 Section 1. The sum of \$3,100,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tax Compliance and
4 Administration Fund to the Department of Revenue for
5 operational expenses of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

6 ARTICLE 7

7 Section 1. The following named amount, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the
9 Department of State Police for the following purposes, but
10 not including personal services:

11 DIVISION OF FORENSIC SERVICES AND IDENTIFICATION

12 For Administration and Operation

13 of State Crime Laboratories:

14 Payable from State Crime Laboratory Fund\$11,000,000

15 ARTICLE 9

16 Section 1. "An Act concerning appropriations", Public
17 Act 99-491, approved December 7, 2015, is amended by changing
18 Section 35 of Article 2 as follows:

19 (P.A. 99-491, Art. 2, Sec. 35)

1 Payable from Nuclear Safety Emergency
 2 Preparedness Fund:
 3 For compensation to local governments
 4 for expenses attributable to implementation
 5 and maintenance of plans and programs
 6 authorized by the Nuclear Safety
 7 Preparedness Act\$650,000

8 Section 15. The sum of \$2,624,000, or so much thereof as
 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
 10 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
 11 for the ordinary and contingent expenses, but not including
 12 personal services, incurred by the Illinois Emergency
 13 Management Agency.

14 Section 25. The sum of \$5,648,600, or so much thereof as
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety
 16 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency
 17 Management Agency for the ordinary and contingent expenses,
 18 but not including personal services, incurred by the Illinois
 19 Emergency Management Agency.

20 Section 30. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof
 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Disaster
 22 Response and Recovery Fund to the Illinois Emergency

1 Management Agency for all current and prior year expenses
2 associated with disaster response and recovery.

3 ARTICLE 90

4 (S.B. 2038, 99th G.A., Article 996 rep.)

5 Section 1. If and only if Senate Bill 2038 of the 99th
6 General Assembly becomes law, then "An Act concerning
7 appropriations" (Senate Bill 2038 of the 99th General
8 Assembly) is amended by repealing Article 996.

9 ARTICLE 99

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
11 becoming law.
