The sum of \$11,200,000, or so much thereof 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Title III Social Security and Employment Fund to the Department of 3 Employment Security for administrative expenses associated 4 with Training and Employment Services in accordance with 5 6 applicable laws and regulations for the state portion of federal funds made available by the American Recovery and 7 Reinvestment Act of 2009. 8

9 Section 45. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Title III Social Security and Employment Fund to the Department of Employment 11 Security pursuant to applicable provisions of Section 903 of 12 Federal Social Security Act, in accordance with 13 the applicable laws and regulations for the state portion of 14 15 federal funds made available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. 16

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July18 1, 2010.
