1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public Act
6 101-0007, approved June 5, 2019, is amended by changing Section
7 20 as follows:

8 (P.A. 101-0007, Article 148, Section 20)

9 GRANTS AND AWARDS

10 Sec. 20. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Road Fund to the
12 Department of Transportation for the objects and purposes
13 hereinafter named:

14 For apportionment to counties for
15 construction of township bridges
16 20 feet or more in length as provided
17 in Section 6-901 through 6-906 of the
18 "Illinois Highway Code"15,000,000

19 For apportionment to needy Townships
20 and Road Districts, as determined by
21 the Department in consultation

1 with the County Superintendents of
2 Highways, Township Highway Commissioners,
3 or Road District Highway
4 Commissioners16,824,100 ~~2,500,000~~
5 For apportionment to high-growth cities
6 over 5,000 in population, as determined
7 by the Department in consultation with
8 the Illinois Municipal League6,720,000 ~~1,000,000~~
9 For apportionment to counties under
10 1,000,000 in population, \$13,440,000 ~~4,000,000~~
11 of the total apportioned in equal
12 amounts to each eligible county,

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect
20 immediately.
