A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
6 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the
7 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent
8 expenses:

2 Section 10. The sum of \$402,007,100, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
4 Assistance Commission from the Education Assistance Fund for
5 payment of Monetary Award Program grant awards to students
6 eligible to receive such awards, as provided by law.

7 Section 11. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
9 Assistance Commission from the Education Assistance Fund for
10 payment of military veterans' scholarships at state-
11 controlled universities and at public community colleges for
12 students eligible, as provided by law.

13 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
14 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
15 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student
16 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

17 Grants and Scholarships

18 For payment of matching grants to Illinois
19 institutions to supplement scholarship
20 programs, as provided by law950,000

21 For the payment of scholarships to students
22 who are children of policemen or firemen

1	killed in the line of duty, or who are	
2	dependents of correctional officers killed	
3	or permanently disabled in the line of	
4	duty, as provided by law	750,000
5	For payment of Illinois National Guard and	
6	Naval Militia Scholarships at	
7	State-controlled universities and public	
8	community colleges in Illinois to students	
9	eligible to receive such awards, as	
10	provided by law	4,480,000
11	For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships	3,000,000
12	For payment of Illinois Scholars Scholarships	3,000,000

19 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
21 Illinois National Guard and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the
22 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
23 purpose:

24 Grants and Scholarships

1 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
2 Naval Militia Scholarships
3 at State-controlled universities
4 and public community colleges in
5 Illinois to students eligible to
6 receive such awards, as provided by law20,000

7 Section 25. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the
10 Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

11 Section 35. The sum of \$1,350,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
14 scholarships and living expenses grants for nursing education
15 students who are pursuing their Master's degree to become
16 nurse faculty.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
19 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs
20 associated with the Veterans' Home Nurses' Loan Repayment
21 Program pursuant to Public Act 95-0576.

1 Section 45. The sum of \$1,000,000 or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 3 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for grants
 4 to eligible public interest attorneys to use for payment of
 5 their educational loans pursuant to Public Act 96-615.

6 Section 50. The following named amount, or so much
 7 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 8 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 9 for the following purpose:

10 Grants and Scholarships

11 For payment of Illinois Future Teacher

12 Corps Scholarships, as provided by law4,000,000

13 Section 55. The following named amount, or so much
 14 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 15 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 16 Commission for the following purpose:

17 To support outreach, research, and

18 training activities2,500,000

19 Section 60. The following named amount, or so much
 20 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 21 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the
 22 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following

1 purpose:

2 Grants and Scholarships

3 For payment of scholarships for the
 4 Optometric Education Scholarship
 5 Program, as provided by law50,000

6

7 Section 65. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
 8 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 9 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
 10 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment
 11 of collection agency fees associated with collection
 12 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default
 13 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary
 14 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

15 Section 70. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as
 16 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 17 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
 18 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and
 19 Maintenance.

20 Section 75. The following named amount, or so much
 21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Student
 22 Loan Operating Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 23 Commission for the following purposes:

1 For payments to the Federal Student
 2 Loan Fund for payment of the federal
 3 default fee on behalf of students,
 4 or for any other lawful purpose
 5 authorized by the Federal Higher
 6 Education Act, as amended10,000,000

7 Section 80. The sum of \$300,000, or so much of that
 8 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts
 9 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 10 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent
 11 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
 12 Act of 1986.

13 Section 85. The following named amount, or so much
 14 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
 15 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
 16 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

17 For payment of Robert C. Byrd
 18 Honors Scholarships3,000,000

19 Section 90. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 21 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
 22 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate

1 Program, as provided by law.

2 Section 95. The following named amount, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
4 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
5 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

6 For transferring repayment funds collected
7 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship
8 Program to the U.S. Treasury400,000

9 Section 100. The following named amount, or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
11 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the
12 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
13 purpose:

14 For payment of scholarships for the
15 Illinois Future Teacher Corps
16 Scholarship Program as provided by law57,000
17 For payment for grants to the Golden Apple
18 Foundation for Excellence in Teaching3,000

19 Section 105. The following named amount, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
21 Student Incentive Trust Fund for the Federal Leveraging
22 Educational Assistance and the Supplemental Leveraging

1 Educational Assistance Programs to the Illinois Student
2 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

3 Grants

4 For payment of Monetary Award Program grants to
5 full-time and part-time students eligible
6 to receive such grants, as provided by law4,000,000

7 Section 110. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
9 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
10 Commission for payment of grants for the Federal College
11 Access Challenge Grant Program, with up to six percent of the
12 funding appropriated to meet allowable administrative costs,
13 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act (CCRAA),
14 as provided by law.

15 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
16 2010.
