### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the University of Illinois for various purposes, including for operational expenses. Effective July 1, 2012.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$686,334,300, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
6 Education Assistance Fund to the Board of the Trustees of the  
7 University of Illinois to meet its operational expenses for  
8 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013.

9 Section 10. The amount of \$800,000, or so much of that  
10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
11 Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
12 University of Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic  
13 Center for Excellence at the Chicago campus.

14 Section 15. The amount of \$328,300, or so much of that  
15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
16 Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
17 University of Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

18 Section 20. The amount of \$1,250,000, or so much of that  
19 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
20 Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the

1 University of Illinois for costs associated with the Public  
2 Policy Institute at the Chicago campus.

3 Section 25. The amount of \$350,000, or so much of that  
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
5 Education Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
6 University of Illinois for costs associated with the College  
7 of Dentistry.

8 Section 30. The amount of \$15,826,500, or so much of  
9 that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
10 Education Assistance Fund to the Board of the Trustees of the  
11 University of Illinois for operating costs and expenses  
12 related to or in support of the Prairie Research Institute.

13 Section 35. The amount of \$2,834,700, or so much of that  
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire  
15 Prevention Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
16 Illinois for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire  
17 Service Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and  
18 providing the facilities and structures incident thereto,  
19 including payment to the University for personal services and  
20 related costs incurred.

21 Section 40. The amount of \$566,900, or so much of that

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire  
2 Prevention Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
3 Illinois for the purpose of implementation and maintenance of  
4 the Cornerstone Training Program at the Illinois Fire Service  
5 Institute.

6 Section 45. The amount of \$250,000, or so much of that  
7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State  
8 College and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
9 the University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in  
10 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

11 Section 50. The amount of \$200,000, or so much of that  
12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
13 Emergency Public Health Fund to the University of Illinois  
14 for costs and expenses related to or in support of emergency  
15 mosquito abatement.

16 Section 55. The amount of \$200,000, or so much of that  
17 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used  
18 Tire Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs  
19 and expenses related to or in support of mosquito research  
20 and abatement.

21 Section 60. The amount of \$425,000, or so much of that

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
2 Hazardous Waste Research Fund to the University of Illinois  
3 for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

4 Section 65. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
6 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
7 University of Illinois for costs associated with the  
8 development, support, or administration of pharmacy practice  
9 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at  
10 Rockford.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
12 2012.
