5 The Department, with the consent in writing from the 6 Governor, may reapportion not more than 10 percent of the total 7 appropriations of General Revenue Funds in Section 25 above among the various purposes therein enumerated. 8

#### ARTICLE 99 9

Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 10 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 11 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 12 13 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
