Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the 7 ordinary and contingent expenses to the Illinois Commerce 8 Commission:

9 Section 10. The sum of \$99,000, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground 11 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 12 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call 13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act. 14

15 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 17 Commerce Commission for refunds. 18

19 Section 25. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Carrier 21 Reimbursement Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for 22 reimbursement of wireless carriers for costs incurred in

3	mandates and for administrative costs incurred by the Illinois

5	Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

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1 Section 35. The sum of \$4,040,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 3 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) 4 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 5 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration 6 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for 7 administrative expenses.

8 Section 45. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as 9 necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois mav be 10 Telecommunications Access Corporation Fund to the Illinois 11 Commerce Commission for administrative costs and for Illinois Telecommunications Access 12 distribution to the 13 Corporation, as required in the Illinois Public Utilities Act, 14 Section 13-703.

15 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 16 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 17 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 18 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
