18	may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
19	Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
20	for licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and
21	thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related
22	costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning
23	of such facilities and for identification, decontamination
24	and environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties

- 1 contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings.
- 2 Section 55. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
- 4 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
- 5 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental
- 6 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under
- 7 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.
- 8 Section 60. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
- 10 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
- 11 for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and
- 12 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses
- 13 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available
- 14 surety.
- 15 Section 65. The sum of \$757,000, or so much thereof as
- 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
- 17 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
- 18 for local responder training, demonstrations, research,
- 19 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the
- 20 Federal Government.
- 21 Section 70. The sum of \$97,000, or so much thereof as

- 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety
- 2 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency
- 3 Management Agency for related training and travel expenses
- 4 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois
- 5 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related
- 6 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel,
- 7 high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste in
- 8 Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency.
- 9 Section 75. The sum of \$271,200, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed
- Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for
- 12 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and
- 13 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site
- 14 near Sheffield, Illinois.
- 15 Section 80. The sum of \$990,000, or so much thereof as
- 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level
- 17 Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to
- 18 the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use in
- 19 accordance with Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level
- 20 Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related to
- 21 establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility.
- 22 Section 85. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as

- 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
- Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 2
- ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois 3
- Emergency Management Agency to include 4 support
- centralized administrative processing center. 5
- 6 Section 90. The sum of \$686,000, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety
- 8 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency
- 9 Management Agency for ordinary and contingent expenses of the
- 10 Illinois Emergency Management Agency to include support of a
- centralized administrative processing center. 11
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 2012. 13
