Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 40. The sum of \$950,000, or so much thereof as

- 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
- 2 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of
- 3 Insurance for costs associated with the administration and
- 4 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois
- 5 Workers' Compensation Commission's anti-fraud program.
- 6 Section 45. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Pension
- 8 Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs
- 9 associated with enrolled contractual actuarial expense.
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 11 2012.
