1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much	
5	thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects	
6	and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board	
7	of the Trustees of Southern Illinois University to meet	
8	ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending	
9	June 30, 2011:	
10	Payable from the General Revenue Fund:	
11	For Personal Services, including payment	
12	to the university for personal services	
13	costs incurred during the fiscal year	
14	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic	
15	personnel for personal services rendered	
16	during the 2010-2011 academic year\$208,928,200

Section 10. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with
the development, support, or administration of pharmacy
practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville
campus.

Section 15. The amount of \$59,000, or so much of that
amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State
College and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of
Southern Illinois University for scholarship grant awards
from the sale of collegiate license plates.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 18 2010.
