I move that House Bill 1001(ss) be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 30, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 12. IC 20-30-5-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.92-2020,
3	SECTION 57, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 13. (a) As used in this section, "appropriate
5	instructor" means an instructor with knowledge of the most recent
5	medically accurate research on human sexuality, pregnancy, and
7	sexually transmitted diseases.
8	(b) As used in this section, "comprehensive sexual health
9	education" means education regarding human development and
)	sexuality, including education on pregnancy, family planning, and
1	sexually transmitted diseases, as well as healthy relationships and

- healthy communication skills.

 (c) As used in this section, "factual information" includes but is not limited to medical, psychiatric, psychological, empirical, and statistical statements.
- (d) As used in this section, "instructor" means an employee, contractor, or consultant of the school district.
- (e) As used in this section, "medically accurate" refers to information that is supported by the weight of research conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods and recognized as accurate and objective by leading professional organizations and agencies with relevant expertise in the field.

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1	(f) Throughout If a state accredited school provides instruction on
2	human sexuality or sexually transmitted diseases, athe state accredited
3	school shall
4	(1) require a teacher to teach abstinence from sexual activity
5	outside of marriage as the expected standard for all school age
6	children;
7	(2) include in the instruction that abstinence from sexual activity
8	is the only certain way to avoid out-of-wedlock pregnancy,
9	sexually transmitted diseases, and other associated health
10	problems; and
11	(3) include in the instruction that the best way to avoid sexually
12	transmitted diseases and other associated health problems is to
13	establish a mutually faithful monogamous relationship in the
14	context of marriage: provide comprehensive sexual health
15	education for any grade level, using appropriate instructors.
16	(g) Instruction and materials used in comprehensive sexual
17	health education under this section shall satisfy all of the following
18	criteria:
19	(1) Be age appropriate.
20	(1) Be age appropriate. (2) Be medically accurate.
21	(3) Be appropriate for use with pupils of all races, genders,
22	
23	sexual orientations, and ethnic and cultural backgrounds, and
24	pupils with disabilities.
25	(4) Encourage pupils to communicate with the pupil's parents
26	about human sexuality.
27	(5) Teach that abstinance from savual intergourse is the only
28	(6) Teach that abstinence from sexual intercourse is the only
29	certain way to prevent unintended pregnancy and sexually
30	transmitted diseases.
31	(7) Provide factual information about the effectiveness and
32	safety, including the health benefits and side effects, of all
33	contraceptive methods in preventing pregnancy and reducing
	the risk of contracting sexually transmitted diseases.
34	(8) Provide pupils with skills for negotiating intimate
35 36	relationships and making and implementing responsible
37	decisions about sexuality.
38	(9) Be appropriate for pupils who choose to be abstinent and
	for those who have been or are sexually active.
39 40	(h) Comprehensive sexual health education provided under this
41	section shall not include any instruction or materials that do either
42	of the following: (1) Teach or promote religious destring
42	(1) Teach or promote religious doctrine.
43	(2) Reflect or promote bias against any person on the basis of
44	race, color, religion, sex, familial status, sexual orientation,
45	disability, or national origin.
40	(i) If a state accredited school provides comprehensive sexual

2	(1) school officials shall notify parents that they have the right
3	to review the curriculum in its entirety and that written and
4	audiovisual educational materials used in the education are
5	available for inspection; and
6	(2) parents have the right to excuse their child from all or
7	parts of the instruction.".
