MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001(ss) be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 30, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 12. IC 20-30-5-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.92-2020,
- 3 SECTION 57, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 13. (a) **As used in this section, "appropriate**
- 5 **instructor" means an instructor with knowledge of the most recent**
- 6 **medically accurate research on human sexuality, pregnancy, and**
- 7 **sexually transmitted diseases.**
- 8 (b) **As used in this section, "comprehensive sexual health**
- 9 **education" means education regarding human development and**
- 10 **sexuality, including education on pregnancy, family planning, and**
- 11 **sexually transmitted diseases, as well as healthy relationships and**
- 12 **healthy communication skills.**
- 13 (c) **As used in this section, "factual information" includes but is**
- 14 **not limited to medical, psychiatric, psychological, empirical, and**
- 15 **statistical statements.**
- 16 (d) **As used in this section, "instructor" means an employee,**
- 17 **contractor, or consultant of the school district.**
- 18 (e) **As used in this section, "medically accurate" refers to**
- 19 **information that is supported by the weight of research conducted**
- 20 **in compliance with accepted scientific methods and recognized as**
- 21 **accurate and objective by leading professional organizations and**
- 22 **agencies with relevant expertise in the field.**

1 **(f) Throughout If a state accredited school provides** instruction on
 2 human sexuality or sexually transmitted diseases, **a the** state accredited
 3 school shall

4 (1) require a teacher to teach abstinence from sexual activity
 5 outside of marriage as the expected standard for all school age
 6 children;

7 (2) include in the instruction that abstinence from sexual activity
 8 is the only certain way to avoid out-of-wedlock pregnancy,
 9 sexually transmitted diseases, and other associated health
 10 problems; and

11 (3) include in the instruction that the best way to avoid sexually
 12 transmitted diseases and other associated health problems is to
 13 establish a mutually faithful monogamous relationship in the
 14 context of marriage: provide comprehensive sexual health
 15 education for any grade level, using appropriate instructors.

16 **(g) Instruction and materials used in comprehensive sexual**
 17 **health education under this section shall satisfy all of the following**
 18 **criteria:**

19 (1) Be age appropriate.

20 (2) Be medically accurate.

21 (3) Be appropriate for use with pupils of all races, genders,
 22 sexual orientations, and ethnic and cultural backgrounds, and
 23 pupils with disabilities.

24 (4) Encourage pupils to communicate with the pupil's parents
 25 about human sexuality.

26 (5) Teach respect for marriage and committed relationships.

27 (6) Teach that abstinence from sexual intercourse is the only
 28 certain way to prevent unintended pregnancy and sexually
 29 transmitted diseases.

30 (7) Provide factual information about the effectiveness and
 31 safety, including the health benefits and side effects, of all
 32 contraceptive methods in preventing pregnancy and reducing
 33 the risk of contracting sexually transmitted diseases.

34 (8) Provide pupils with skills for negotiating intimate
 35 relationships and making and implementing responsible
 36 decisions about sexuality.

37 (9) Be appropriate for pupils who choose to be abstinent and
 38 for those who have been or are sexually active.

39 **(h) Comprehensive sexual health education provided under this**
 40 **section shall not include any instruction or materials that do either**
 41 **of the following:**

42 (1) Teach or promote religious doctrine.

43 (2) Reflect or promote bias against any person on the basis of
 44 race, color, religion, sex, familial status, sexual orientation,
 45 disability, or national origin.

46 **(i) If a state accredited school provides comprehensive sexual**

- 1 **health education under this section:**
- 2 **(1) school officials shall notify parents that they have the right**
- 3 **to review the curriculum in its entirety and that written and**
- 4 **audiovisual educational materials used in the education are**
- 5 **available for inspection; and**
- 6 **(2) parents have the right to excuse their child from all or**
- 7 **parts of the instruction."**

8 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
