MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1001(ss) be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 25, after line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 7. IC 12-7-2-22, AS AMENDED BY P.L.86-2018,
3 SECTION 152, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 22. "Board" means the
5 following:
6 **(1) For purposes of IC 12-8-6.5-13, the meaning set forth in**
7 **IC 12-8-6.5-13(a).**
8 (+) **(2)** For purposes of IC 12-10-10 and IC 12-10-11, the
9 community and home options to institutional care for the elderly
10 and disabled board established by IC 12-10-11-1.
11 (±) **(3)** For purposes of IC 12-11-14, the meaning set forth in
12 IC 12-11-14-3.
13 (±) **(4)** For purposes of IC 12-12-7-5, the meaning set forth in
14 IC 12-12-7-5(a).
15 (±) **(5)** For purposes of IC 12-15-35, the meaning set forth in
16 IC 12-15-35-2.
17 SECTION 8. IC 12-7-2-69.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
18 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE**
19 **UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 69.7. "Doula" means an individual who is**
20 **trained and certified by a nationally recognized institution in**

1 providing emotional and physical support, but not medical or
 2 midwife care, to pregnant and birthing persons before, during, and
 3 after childbirth.

4 SECTION 9. IC 12-8-6.5-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 5 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 6 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 13. (a) As used in this section, "board"
 7 refers to the doula reimbursement advisory board established by
 8 subsection (b).

9 (b) The doula reimbursement advisory board is established for
 10 the purpose of making recommendations to the office of the
 11 secretary regarding appropriate reimbursement methodologies for
 12 doula services.

13 (c) The board is comprised of the following members:

14 (1) Four (4) legislative members appointed as follows:

15 (A) One (1) member of the senate, appointed by the
 16 president pro tempore of the senate.

17 (B) One (1) member of the senate, appointed by the
 18 minority leader of the senate.

19 (C) One (1) member of the house of representatives,
 20 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

21 (D) One (1) member of the house of representatives,
 22 appointed by the minority leader of the house of
 23 representatives.

24 (2) Nine (9) lay members appointed as follows, subject to
 25 subsections (d) and (e):

26 (A) One (1) member appointed by the governor.

27 (B) One (1) member appointed by the president pro
 28 tempore of the senate.

29 (C) One (1) member appointed by the minority leader of
 30 the senate.

31 (D) One (1) member appointed by the speaker of the house
 32 of representatives.

33 (E) One (1) member appointed by the minority leader of
 34 the house of representatives.

35 (F) One (1) member appointed by the secretary.

36 (G) One (1) member appointed by the state health
 37 commissioner.

38 (H) One (1) member appointed by the director of the
 39 department of child services.

40 (I) One member appointed by chief operating officer of the
 41 Indiana Minority Health Coalition.

42 (d) A lay member of the board must be a doula, doula
 43 administrator, or other birthing professional.

44 (e) The lay membership of the board must be racially and
 45 ethnically diverse.

46 (f) In making recommendations to the office of the secretary
 47 under subsection (b), the board shall study and take into account

- 1 **doula reimbursement methodologies used by other states."**
- 2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
