



# SENATE MOTION

**MADAM PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1104 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 6, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 5. IC 20-34-4.5-0.2, AS ADDED BY P.L.117-2017,  
3           SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
4           JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 0.2. As used in this chapter, "emergency  
5           medication" means any of the following:  
6           (1) Albuterol.  
7           (2) Epinephrine.  
8           (3) ~~Naloxone, as an overdose intervention drug~~ **An opioid**  
9           **overdose reversal drug, including nasal spray**, that is subject  
10          to IC 16-42-27.  
11          SECTION 6. IC 20-34-4.5-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.164-2023,  
12          SECTION 55, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
13          JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 1. (a) **Except as provided in subsection (c)**, a  
14          school or a school corporation may:  
15          (1) fill a prescription or statewide standing order for an  
16          emergency medication; ~~and~~  
17          (2) store the emergency medication:  
18              (A) if the prescription or statewide standing order is filled by  
19              a school, in the school; or  
20              (B) if the prescription or statewide standing order is filled by  
21              a school corporation, in a school in the school corporation;  
22          **and**  
23          **(3) work in cooperation with an opioid overdose prevention**  
24          **organization to carry out the purposes of this chapter;**  
25          if a health care provider who is licensed in Indiana and whose scope of  
26          practice includes the prescribing of medication writes the prescription  
27          or the state health commissioner issues a statewide standing order for

1 the emergency medication for the school or school corporation.

2 (b) The school shall store the emergency medication in a safe  
3 location in which only school employees have access.

4 **(c) A school or a school corporation shall:**

5 **(1) fill a statewide standing order for an opioid overdose**  
6 **reversal drug, including nasal spray; and**

7 **(2) store the opioid overdose reversal drug, including nasal**  
8 **spray, in a location in the school that is readily accessible for**  
9 **use by a school nurse or by a school employee who has**  
10 **received training described in section 2 of this chapter.**

11 SECTION 7. IC 20-34-4.5-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.164-2023,  
12 SECTION 56, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
13 JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 3. (a) A health care provider who is licensed in  
14 Indiana and whose scope of practice includes the prescribing of  
15 medication may:

16 (1) write; or

17 (2) transmit in an electronic format for an electronically  
18 transmitted prescription;

19 a prescription, drug order, or protocol for an emergency medication for  
20 a school or school corporation.

21 (b) **Except as provided in subsection (d),** the state health  
22 commissioner or the state health commissioner's designee who is a  
23 licensed prescriber may issue a statewide standing order, prescription,  
24 or protocol for emergency stock medication for schools or school  
25 corporations.

26 (c) **Except as provided in subsection (e),** a pharmacist licensed  
27 under IC 25-26 may dispense a valid prescription, drug order, standing  
28 order, or protocol for an emergency medication issued in the name of  
29 a school or school corporation.

30 **(d) The state health commissioner or the state health**  
31 **commissioner's designee who is a licensed prescriber shall issue a**  
32 **statewide standing order or prescription for an opioid overdose**  
33 **reversal drug, including nasal spray, for each:**

34 **(1) school; or**

35 **(2) school corporation on behalf of each school.**

36 **The standing order or prescription shall provide at least one (1)**  
37 **carton of an opioid overdose reversal drug per five hundred (500)**  
38 **students enrolled at a school.**

39 **(e) A pharmacist licensed under IC 25-26 shall dispense a valid**  
40 **prescription, standing order, or protocol for an opioid overdose**  
41 **reversal drug, including nasal spray, issued in the name of a school**

- 1 **or school corporation on behalf of each school."**
- 2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
