## DIGEST

Prohibited persons. Provides that a "prohibited person", for purposes of the bill's restriction on transfer, licensing, or sublicensing of intellectual property by state educational institutions, includes businesses organized under the laws of, headquartered in, owned or controlled by citizens of, or directly controlled by any of the following: (1) China. (2) Iran. (3) North Korea. (4) Russia. (5) A foreign government designated under specified federal law. (6) A country designated as a threat to critical infrastructure by the governor.
