Prohibited person. Adds a definition of "controlling person". Changes the definition of "prohibited person" to include only those business entities with a controlling person who is a citizen or business entity of a foreign adversary.

19	(1) An individual who is a citizen of a foreign adversary (as

21	(2) A foreign business entity organized under the laws of a
22	foreign adversary (as defined in 15 CFR 7.4).
23	(3) A corporation, professional corporation, nonprofit
24	corporation, limited liability company, partnership, or limited

27	(A) An individual who is a citizen of a foreign adversary

2 (B) A company or other entity, including a governmental
