PROPOSED AMENDMENT HB 1258 # 1

DIGEST

Mobile retail food establishment permits. Removes provisions in the bill requiring a local health department to: (1) establish standards concerning mobile retail food establishments; and (2) prescribe an application form. Requires a local health department to issue a mobile retail food establishment and inspect a mobile retail food establishment in accordance with administrative rules adopted by the Indiana department of health (state department). Changes the maximum amount a local health department may charge for an inspection from \$25 to \$50. Provides that a local health department may not adopt standards concerning mobile retail food establishments that are more stringent than the rules adopted by the state department.

12	(B) that does not exceed one hundred fifty dollars (\$150).
13	(2) Establish an inspection fee:
14	(A) to be paid for each inspection of a mobile retail food
15	establishment; and
16	(B) that does not exceed fifty dollars (\$50).".
17	Page 3, delete line 1.
18	Page 3, between lines 22 and 23, begin a new paragraph and insert:
19	"Sec. 7. A local health department may not adopt standards
20	concerning mobile retail food establishments that are more
21	stringent than the rules adopted by the state department under
22	IC 4-22-2. ".
23	Page 3, line 23, delete "Sec. 7." and insert "Sec. 8.".
