PROPOSED AMENDMENT HB 1285 # 5

DIGEST

Various education matters. Provides that a school corporation may not remove a student's property without providing the student's parent with the opportunity to collect the student's property if the student has transferred, dropped out, or otherwise withdrawn from enrollment in the school corporation for any reason. Requires a school corporation to ensure at least one employee in each school building that is used for classroom instruction: (1) has obtained nonviolent crisis intervention training; and (2) is present in the school building during the school year while school is in session. Establishes requirements regarding the employee. Provides that the special education transparency requirements in the bill are subject to available funding. Amends the special education transparency requirements. Removes provisions in the bill regarding: (1) the special education classroom grant program; and (2) behavior interventionist requirements.

29	"Sec. 4. (a) After January 1, 2026, a teacher or other school staff

31	(1) whose primary responsibility is to provide instruction or
32	assistance to students; and
33	(2) who works in a designated room or area of a school that is
34	required to have electronic recording equipment under
35	section 2 of this chapter;
36	may request to review any electronic recording of the room or area
37	in which the teacher or other school staff works.
38	(b) Upon receipt of a request by a teacher or other school staff
39	under subsection (a), a school corporation must do the following:
40	(1) Immediately preserve any electronic recording that exists.

(2) Not later than five (5) business days after the date the
 school corporation receives the request, make the recording
 available to the teacher or school staff.".
