MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1365 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 9, strike lines 20 through 42.
- 2 Page 10, strike lines 1 through 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 **"(e) If the county voter registration office determines that the**
- 4 **voter is described by subsection (d), the county voter registration**
- 5 **office may not cancel the voter's registration unless:**
- 6 **(1) the voter confirms in writing to the county voter**
- 7 **registration office that the voter has changed residence to a**
- 8 **place outside the county in which the voter is registered; or**
- 9 **(2) both of the following apply to the voter:**
- 10 **(A) The voter has failed to respond to a notice described in**
- 11 **subsection (f).**
- 12 **(B) The voter has not voted or appeared to vote in an**
- 13 **election during the period beginning on the date of the**
- 14 **notice and ending on the day after the date of the second**
- 15 **general election for federal office that occurs after the date**
- 16 **of the notice.**

1 **(f) The notice referred to in subsection (e)(2)(A) must be a**
2 **postage prepaid and pre-addressed return card, sent by forwarded**
3 **mail, on which the voter may state the voter's current address."**
