HOUSE MOTION

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1365 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 9, strike lines 20 through 42.
2	Page 10, strike lines 1 through 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
3	"(e) If the county voter registration office determines that the
4	voter is described by subsection (d), the county voter registration
5	office may not cancel the voter's registration unless:
6	(1) the voter confirms in writing to the county voter
7	registration office that the voter has changed residence to a
8	place outside the county in which the voter is registered; or
9	(2) both of the following apply to the voter:
10	(A) The voter has failed to respond to a notice described in
11	subsection (f).
12	(B) The voter has not voted or appeared to vote in an
13	election during the period beginning on the date of the
14	notice and ending on the day after the date of the second
15	general election for federal office that occurs after the date
16	of the notice.

2	postage prepaid and pre-addressed return card, sent by forwarded		
3	mail, on which the voter may state the voter's current address.".
