



# SENATE MOTION

**MADAM PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1365 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 4, delete lines 31 through 38.
- 2 Page 7, between lines 2 and 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 13. IC 3-7-26.4-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.141-2020,
- 4 SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 4. (a) The election division may provide parts and
- 6 reports from the voter registration information from the computerized
- 7 list for the purposes specified under IC 3-7-26.3-29.
- 8 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the parts and
- 9 reports provided under this section may not include information
- 10 described under section 8 of this chapter.
- 11 (c) The parts and reports may contain the information described in
- 12 section 8 of this chapter if:
- 13 (1) the part or report is to be provided to an entity that:
- 14 (A) is described in section 6 of this chapter; and
- 15 (B) has previously submitted an application to the election
- 16 division and paid any required fee to obtain the complete
- 17 compilation; or
- 18 (2) the part or report is a purely statistical compilation that:
- 19 (A) includes the information described in section 8 of this
- 20 chapter; and
- 21 (B) does not include any information:
- 22 (i) concerning an individual voter; or
- 23 (ii) that would permit the identification of an individual
- 24 voter as a result of providing the compilation.
- 25 (d) The parts and reports provided under this section may not
- 26 include the complete Social Security number of any individual.
- 27 (e) The election division may provide the registration information

1 described in section 8 of this chapter, including an individual's voting  
2 history, as follows:

3 (1) To states and local governments in states that are  
4 implementing any voter list maintenance program described in  
5 IC 3-7-38.2-5, including a program implemented with information  
6 obtained from another state under IC 3-7-38.2-5.5.

7 (2) Upon written request, to law enforcement officials conducting  
8 an investigation. **The election division shall determine the  
9 confidence factor score, according to IC 3-7-38.2-5.5(c)(2), of  
10 the voter registration information being provided to the law  
11 enforcement official and do the following:**

12 **(A) If the confidence score is seventy-five (75) points or  
13 more, provide the registration information and a statement  
14 regarding the score. The statement must state that the  
15 election division is not making a determination that the  
16 information is about the same individual the law  
17 enforcement official is inquiring about.**

18 **(B) If the confidence score is below seventy-five (75) points,  
19 provide the registration information and a statement  
20 regarding the low confidence score. The statement must  
21 state that the election division is not making a  
22 determination that the information is about the same  
23 individual the law enforcement official is inquiring about."**

24 Page 20, line 29, delete "seventy-four (74)" and insert "sixty-seven  
25 (67)".

26 Page 20, line 39, delete "seventy-four (74)" and insert "sixty (60)".  
27 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
