## HOUSE MOTION

## MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1577 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 15, after line 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 10. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021] (a) This state and all
3	political subdivisions of this state shall enforce this act without
4	regard to Roe v. Wade.
5	(b) Pursuant to the sovereign authority of this state, this state
6	and all political subdivisions of this state are prohibited from using
7	any personnel or financial resources to enforce, administer, or
8	cooperate with Roe v. Wade to prevent this state or its political
9	subdivisions from enforcing this act to protect the lives of people
10	who have not yet been born.
11	(c) No government agency or official of this state or its political
12	subdivisions, including any sheriff, deputy sheriff, or other law
13	enforcement officer, shall give force or effect to any court order
14	that conflicts with this SECTION. Cooperative agreements with
15	federal agencies notwithstanding, no law enforcement agency or
16	law enforcement officer in this state shall assist or cooperate in any
17	way with the arrest or imprisonment of any government official or
18	individual who complies with this SECTION and refuses to comply
19	with any contrary court order. Such contrary orders shall include,
20	but not be limited to, any order to levy upon property, seize bank
21	accounts, arrest the person, or serve process for the purpose of
22	causing any person to violate this SECTION, or for the purpose of

1 punishing any person for the failure to comply with an order 2 contrary to this SECTION. A federal office or agent who arrests 3 any state or local government official for compliance with this 4 section shall be subject to arrest by state or local law enforcement. 5 (d) The attorney general shall, upon request of an employee or 6 former employee of the state or a political subdivision thereof, 7 provide for the defense of any action brought against such 8 employee or former employee on account of an act or omission in 9

the scope of employment relating to this SECTION.

10 (e) A violation of subsection (b) or (c) is a class A misdemeanor. 11 (f) A person who violates this SECTION while acting in the 12 person's official capacity shall be subject to termination from 13 employment to the extent allowable under state law and, if such 14 person is a public servant at the time of conviction, shall forfeit the

15 person's office.

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(g) Any aggrieved party may bring a private cause of action against a person who violates or attempts to violate this SECTION.

18 (h) For purposes of this SECTION, "Roe v. Wade" means the 19 opinions and judgments of the Supreme Court of the United States 20 in Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113 (1973) and its judicial progeny, past 21 and future, including, but not limited to, Planned Parenthood v. 22 Casey 505 U.S. 833 (1992) and June Med. Servs. L.L.C. v. Russo 23 140 S. Ct. 2103 (2020).".
