## DIGEST

Attendant care services. Requires the legislative services agency to submit a report to the legislative council concerning the provision of attendant care services by legally responsible individuals.

| 11 | (c) As used in this SECTION, "legally responsible individual"         |
| 12 | means:  |
| 13 | (1) the parent, guardian, or other relative who is legally            |
| 14 | responsible for a minor child; or                                     |
| 15 | (2) the spouse of an individual;                                      |
| 16 | receiving home and community based services under a home and          |
| 17 | community based services Medicaid waiver.                             |
| 18 | (d) As used in this SECTION, "office" means the office of the         |
| 19 | secretary of family and social services established by IC 12-8-1.5-1. |
| 20 | (e) Not later than October 1, 2024, the legislative services agency   |
| 21 | shall prepare and submit a report to the legislative council in an    |
| 22 | electronic format under IC 5-14-6 concerning the transition of        |
| 23 | providing Medicaid reimbursement to legally responsible               |
| 24 | individuals for the provision of attendant care services under a      |
| 25 | home and community based services Medicaid waiver, as in effect       |
| 26 | January 1, 2024, to instead provide for attendant care services by    |
| 27 | legally responsible individuals under the structured family           |

| 1  | caregiving program, or another program administered by the          |
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| 2  | office. The report must include at least the following information: |
| 3  | (1) An assessment of whether the structured family caregiving       |
| 4  | program, or another program administered by the office, to          |
| 5  | which the provision of attendant care services by legally           |
| 6  | responsible individuals is transitioned, will provide for           |
| 7  | substantially similar benefits and coverage of activities as was    |
| 8  | provided to legally responsible individuals for the provision       |
| 9  | of attendant care services under a home and community               |
| 10 | based services Medicaid waiver, as in effect January 1, 2024.       |
| 11 | (2) An assessment of whether an adequate provider network           |
| 12 | is available when the provision of attendant care services by       |
| 13 | legally responsible individuals is transitioned to the structured   |
| 14 | family caregiving program, or another program administered          |
| 15 | by the office.  |
| 16 | (3) A review of the ability of a legally responsible individual     |
| 17 | providing attendant care services under the structured family       |
| 18 | caregiving program, or another program administered by the          |
| 19 | office, to obtain insurance for pediatric services.                 |
| 20 | (f) This SECTION expires July 1, 2026.".                            |
