



SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 5 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 9, after "1." insert "**(a) This chapter does not apply to**
2 **any of the following licenses:**
3 **(1) Any type of social work license issued under IC 25-23.6-5.**
4 **(2) Any type of marriage and family therapist license issued**
5 **under IC 25-23.6-8.**
6 **(3) Any type of respiratory care practitioner license under**
7 **IC 25-34.5.**
8 **(b)".**
9 Page 4, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new paragraph and insert:
10 "SECTION 3. IC 25-35.6-1-5.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.216-2021,
11 SECTION 51, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
12 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5.5. **(a)** An individual may practice
13 speech-language pathology in Indiana under a license to practice
14 speech-language pathology issued by a state that has entered into a
15 reciprocity agreement with the board under which an individual
16 licensed to practice speech-language pathology in Indiana is authorized
17 to practice speech-language pathology in the other state under the
18 individual's Indiana speech-language pathology license.
19 **(b) Before January 1, 2023, the board shall initiate and make**
20 **every effort to enter into a reciprocity agreement with another**
21 **state that:**
22 **(1) is contiguous to Indiana; and**
23 **(2) is not a member of an interstate compact with Indiana**
24 **concerning speech-language pathology;**
25 **that would allow an individual licensed to practice speech-language**
26 **pathology in Indiana or the other state to practice in the other state**
27 **under the individual's speech-language pathology license.**

1 SECTION 4. IC 25-35.6-1-6.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.216-2021,
2 SECTION 52, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 6.5. **(a)** An individual may practice audiology
4 in Indiana under a license to practice audiology issued by a state that
5 has entered into a reciprocity agreement with the board under which an
6 individual licensed to practice audiology in Indiana is authorized to
7 practice audiology in the other state under the individual's Indiana
8 audiology license.

9 **(b) Before January 1, 2023, the board shall initiate and make**
10 **every effort to enter into a reciprocity agreement with another**
11 **state that:**

12 **(1) is contiguous to Indiana; and**

13 **(2) is not a member of an interstate compact with Indiana**
14 **concerning audiology;**

15 **that would allow an individual licensed to practice audiology in**
16 **Indiana or the other state to practice in the other state under the**
17 **individual's audiology license."**

18 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
