# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 8 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 2, line 2, after "than July 1," insert "**2027, the department**
- 2           **shall make all Indiana college core courses described in**
- 3           **IC 21-42-3-2 available online to all eligible students through the**
- 4           **course access program created under this chapter.**
- 5           **(b) Not later than July 1, 2025, the department shall partner**
- 6           **with state educational institutions, approved postsecondary**
- 7           **educational institutions (as defined in IC 21-7-13-6(a)), or both, to**
- 8           **carry out the purposes described in subsection (a)."**
- 9           Page 2, delete lines 3 through 10.
- 10          Page 2, line 15, delete "developed under IC 21-42-3 that is offered
- 11          by" and insert "**(as described in IC 21-42-3),"**
- 12          Page 2, line 16, delete "a state educational institution,".
- 13          Page 2, between lines 21 and 22, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 14          "**SECTION 4. IC 20-36-5-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.10-2019,**
- 15          **SECTION 88, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE**
- 16          **JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 1. A student shall receive credits toward**
- 17          **graduation or an Indiana diploma with a Core 40 with academic honors**
- 18          **designation by demonstrating the student's proficiency in a course or**
- 19          **subject area required for graduation or the Indiana diploma with a Core**
- 20          **40 with academic honors designation, whether or not the student has**

1 completed course work in the subject area, by any one (1) or more of  
2 the following methods:

3 (1) Receiving a score that demonstrates proficiency on a  
4 standardized assessment of academic or subject area competence  
5 that is accepted by accredited postsecondary educational  
6 institutions.

7 (2) Successfully completing a similar course at an eligible  
8 institution under the postsecondary enrollment program under  
9 IC 21-43-4.

10 (3) Receiving a score of three (3), four (4), or five (5) on an  
11 advanced placement examination for a course or subject area.

12 (4) Receiving a score of E(e) or higher on a Cambridge  
13 International Advanced A or AS level examination for a course or  
14 subject area.

15 **(5) Successfully completing an International Baccalaureate**  
16 **course under IC 20-36-7-3.**

17 ~~(5)~~ **(6) Other methods approved by the state board."**

18 Page 2, line 39, delete "but not limited to the Indiana College Core  
19 (IC 21-42-3)," and insert "**the Indiana College Core (as described in**  
20 **IC 21-42-3),"**

21 Page 3, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
22 "SECTION 5. IC 20-36-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
23 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
24 JULY 1, 2024]:

25 **Chapter 7. International Baccalaureate Courses**

26 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "International Baccalaureate**  
27 **course" refers to a course from the International Baccalaureate**  
28 **diploma program.**

29 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "International Baccalaureate**  
30 **examination" refers to an International Baccalaureate diploma**  
31 **program examination.**

32 **Sec. 3. (a) Successful completion of an International**  
33 **Baccalaureate course shall count as high school credit towards**  
34 **completing Indiana graduation requirements.**

35 **(b) Any rule adopted by the state board or the department**  
36 **concerning an Indiana diploma with a Core 40 with academic**  
37 **honors designation must provide that a successfully completed**  
38 **International Baccalaureate course is credited toward fulfilling the**  
39 **requirements of an Indiana diploma with a Core 40 with academic**  
40 **honors designation.**

41 **(c) If a high school student who takes an International**  
42 **Baccalaureate examination receives a score of four (4) or higher on**  
43 **the examination, the student is entitled to receive postsecondary**  
44 **level academic credit at a state educational institution that counts**  
45 **toward meeting the student's degree requirements if the elective**  
46 **credit is part of the student's degree requirements. Credit**

1       **equivalencies, including Indiana College Core (as described in**  
2 **IC 21-42-3), for all International Baccalaureate examinations must**  
3 **be:**

4           **(1) updated annually and sent by each state educational**  
5 **institution to the commission for higher education by June 1**  
6 **each year; and**

7           **(2) posted by the state educational institution on the**  
8 **institution's website by July 1 each year.**

9       **The commission for higher education shall post these annually**  
10 **updated credit equivalencies on the commission for higher**  
11 **education's student transfer of credit portal by July 1 each year.**

12       **(d) A state educational institution may require a score higher**  
13 **than a score of four (4) on an International Baccalaureate**  
14 **examination if the credit is to be used for meeting a course**  
15 **requirement for a particular major at the state educational**  
16 **institution."**

17       Page 14, between lines 34 and 35, begin a new paragraph and insert:

18       "SECTION 11. IC 21-42-3-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007,  
19 SECTION 283, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
20 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 4. **(a) Until June 30, 2027**, based  
21 upon the demand for enrollment in a course identified under section 2  
22 of this chapter and the resources available to the state educational  
23 institutions, an identified course shall be offered through:

- 24           (1) onsite instruction;
- 25           (2) telecommunication; or
- 26           (3) a combination of methods described in subdivisions (1) and
- 27           (2);

28       at on-campus or off-campus sites.

29       **(b) Beginning July 1, 2027, a course identified under section 2**  
30 **of this chapter may be offered through the Indiana course access**  
31 **program pursuant to IC 20-30-16-14."**

32       Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
