MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 197 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 22, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 18. IC 16-39-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	JULY 1, 2021]:
5	Chapter 11. Coerced Release of Health Information
6	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "coerced release of health
7	information" means a requirement that an individual disclose
8	personal health information, including the individual's vaccination
9	status or the results of an invasive test, as a condition of entering
10	or participating in a gathering or function.
11	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "invasive test" means any form
12	of testing to determine whether an individual has or has had an
13	infection, including:
14	(1) a nasal swab;
15	(2) blood testing; or
16	(3) any other procedure by means of penetrating the skin or
17	a body opening.
18	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "vaccination" means the
19	treatment of an individual with a vaccine or other measure
20	intended to produce immunity.
21	Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "vaccination status" means the
22	status of an individual in regard to:

1	(1) having received; or
2	(2) not having received;
3	a vaccination.
4	Sec. 5. An individual may not:
5	(1) require a member of the public to provide documentation
6	regarding an individual's vaccination status;
7	(2) require a member of the public to provide documentation
8	of an invasive test; or
9	(3) restrict participation in an event occurring in or use of a
10	public area of the premises of the state, local government, or
11	business based on an individual's vaccination status or
12	whether the individual has had an invasive test.
13	Sec. 6. A person who knowingly or intentionally violates section
14	5 of this chapter commits coerced release of health information, a
15	Class A misdemeanor.
16	Sec. 7. This chapter is intended to supplement state and federal
17	laws protecting the safety and privacy of individuals receiving
18	health care services by prohibiting the coerced release of health
19	information. This chapter must be construed in a manner that is
20	compatible with those laws.".
21	Page 90, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
22	"SECTION 96. IC 35-52-16-35.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
23	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
24	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 35.5. IC 16-39-11-6 defines a
25	crime concerning the coerced release of health information.".
26	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
