## PROPOSED AMENDMENT SB 202 # 6

## **DIGEST**

State educational institutions. Adds member appointments by the legislative council to the board of trustees of state educational institutions (board of trustees). Requires the governor, through the membership appointments by the governor, to ensure intellectual and ideological diversity of the membership of each board of trustees. Requires each state educational institution to report certain information at the time the institution submits its legislative budget request. Provides that a board of trustees member who is a state employee is not entitled to per diem but is entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses and other certain expenses. Removes certain criteria requirements for boards of trustees of state educational institutions.
