MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 211 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2	paragraph and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. IC 4-6-2-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
4	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
5	1, 2024]: Sec. 13. (a) As used in this section, "school complaint
6	website" means a publicly facing website that does one (1) or more
7	of the following:
8	(1) Allows a person to submit a complaint or comment about
9	a school.
10	(2) Publishes a complaint or comment about a school that is
11	submitted by a person other than the attorney general.
12	The term includes the Eyes on Education website or any similar
13	successor website.
14	(b) The attorney general may not establish, operate, or maintain
15	a school complaint website.
16	(c) The attorney general may not:
17	(1) investigate;
18	(2) make a public records request with regard to;
19	(3) publish; or
20	(4) take any other action regarding;
21	a complaint, comment, or any other information submitted
22	through a school complaint website.".

1	Page 2, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 3. IC 20-20-51 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	JULY 1, 2024]:
5	Chapter 51. School Complaint Submission Website
6	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "governing authority" refers to:
7	(1) the governing body of a school corporation; or
8	(2) the equivalent authority of a governing body as described
9	in subdivision (1) for a:
10	(A) charter school; or
11	(B) state accredited nonpublic school.
12	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "school" refers to the following:
13	(1) A school maintained by a school corporation.
14	(2) A charter school.
15	(3) A state accredited nonpublic school.
16	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "school complaint submission
17	website" means a publicly facing website that allows a person to
18	submit a complaint or comment about a school.
19	Sec. 4. The department shall establish and maintain a school
20	complaint submission website.

	Sec. 5. If the department receives a complaint or comment
22	regarding a school through the school complaint submission
23	website, the department shall provide to the governing authority
24	of the school:
25	(1) the complaint or comment; and
26	(2) any documents or other information submitted through
27	the school complaint submission website regarding the
28	complaint or comment.
29	Sec. 6. The department may not:
30	(1) investigate;
31	(2) make a public records request with regard to;
32	(3) publish; or
33	(4) take any other action regarding;
34	a complaint, comment, or any other information submitted

	through the school complaint submission website.
36	Sec. 7. (a) Not later than thirty (30) days after the date the
37	governing authority of a school receives a complaint or comment
38	from the department under section 5 of this chapter, the governing
39	authority shall do the following:
40	(1) Review the complaint or comment.
41	(2) If the complaint or comment was submitted by a:
42	(A) parent of a student of the school; or
43	(B) resident of the school corporation, as applicable;
44	investigate and respond to the parent or resident regarding
45	the complaint or comment.
46	(b) A response to a parent or resident under subsection (a)(2)
40	must provide an explanation of the outcome of the investigation.".
