MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on **Ways and Means** , to which was referred House Bill
1001(ss), has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the
House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 25, after line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 7. IC 12-15-2-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.117-2022,
- 3 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 13. (a) A pregnant woman whose family
- 5 income does not exceed the income level established in subsection (b)
- 6 is eligible to receive Medicaid coverage under 42 CFR 435.116.
- 7 (b) A pregnant woman described in this section is eligible to receive
- 8 Medicaid, subject to subsection (c) and 42 U.S.C. 1396a et seq., if her
- 9 family income does not exceed two hundred eight percent (208%) of
- 10 the federal income poverty level for the same size family.
- 11 (c) Medicaid is available to a pregnant woman described in this
- 12 section for:
- 13 (1) the duration of the pregnancy; and

1 (2) a period of time determined by the office of the secretary.
2 The postpartum period of time determined by the office of the secretary
3 must **not** be ~~at least sixty (60) days but not more~~ **less** than twelve (12)
4 months of a postpartum period that begins on the last day of the
5 pregnancy, without regard to any change in income of the family of
6 which she is a member during that time."

7 Page 27, line 2, delete "screening." and insert "**screening for all**
8 **pregnant women at any time during pregnancy. Prior**
9 **authorization may not be required for noninvasive prenatal**
10 **screening and routine carrier screening.**".

11 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
(Reference is to HB 1001(ss) as introduced.)
