<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> This bill provides that an emergency medical services provider agency that is operated by a county is eligible for a mobile integration healthcare grant.

Effective Date: July 1, 2025.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The Department of Homeland Security's Emergency Medical Services Commission (Commission) will need to update documentation to include counties as eligible applicants for mobile integration healthcare grants and may receive additional applications for review. This is within the Commission's routine administrative functions and should be able to be implemented using existing staffing and resources.

<u>Additional Information:</u> The Commission was appropriated \$500,000 each year for the FY 2024-FY 2025 biennium. The Commission offered grants ranging from \$50,000 to \$75,000 in FY 2024 and awarded the full appropriation of \$500,000 to 8 applicants. As of August 2024, the Commission has awarded \$400,000 to 6 applicants and intends to have an additional round of applications to award the remaining \$100,000.
