## **MR. SPEAKER:**

*Your Committee on* <u>**Roads and Transportation**</u>, to which was referred <u>House Bill</u> <u>1072</u>, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

1	Page 1, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"Sec. 0.5. This chapter does not apply to portions of state routes,
3	U.S. routes, and interstate highways comprising the state highway
4	system located in a municipality.".
5	Page 3, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and insert:
6	"Sec. 10. A political subdivision may not be required to:
7	(1) install additional traffic signs or signals;
8	(2) make improvements or extensions to infrastructure; or
9	(3) pay for improvements to infrastructure;

- 1 for the purpose of accommodating or providing increased access
- 2 for personal delivery devices.".
- 3 Page 3, line 16, delete "10." and insert "**11.**". (Reference is to HB 1072 as introduced.)
