<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> This bill adds a provision that provides that the requirements of the Student and Parent Support Services Grant Program do not prevent a school corporation, charter school, or state accredited nonpublic school from providing school based treatment services or treatment services provided by an outside provider to address the comprehensive needs and well-being of a student.

<u>Explanation of Local Expenditures:</u> The fiscal impact will depend on local action. Currently, certain services for at-risk students can be funded by a grant from the Indiana Secured School Fund under the Student and Parent Support Services Grant Program.
