MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on <u>Ways and Means</u>, to which was referred <u>House Bill 1135</u>, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

1	Page 2, line 5, strike "and".
2	Page 2, line 6, after "schools;" insert "and
3	(C) apprenticeship programs;".
4	Page 2, delete line 39, begin a new line block indented and insert:
5	"(2) A statement that the cosmetologist has at least five (5)
6	years of salon experience.
7	(3) A statement that the cosmetologist has completed a one
8	hundred (100) hour methodology course.
9	(4) A statement that the cosmetologist has successfully passed
10	the state PSI cosmetology test.".
11	Page 2, line 40, delete "(3)" and insert "(5)".
12	Page 2, line 42, delete "(4)" and insert "(6)".
13	Page 3, delete lines 8 through 12, begin a new line block indented

1	and insert:
2	"(2) Ensure that the apprentice will not perform licensed
3	regulated work on the general public until the after
4	apprentice has received two hundred (200) hours of technical
5	training.".
6	Page 3, delete lines 19 through 23, begin a new paragraph and
7	insert:
8	"(e) A cosmetologist may not train more than two (2)
9	apprentices at any time. Each cosmetologist establishment
10	may not have more than:
11	(1) six (6) apprentices as any time; or
12	(2) three (3) approved cosmetologist licensing apprentices at
13	any time.".
14	Page 3, between lines 28 and 29, begin a new paragraph and insert:
15	"(g) A cosmetology apprentice must complete one thousand five
16	hundred (1,500) hours of instruction and training which must be
17	completed in two (2) years.
18	(h) A cosmetology apprentice may:
19	(1) transfer to a beauty culture school; and
20	(2) use each one hour of credit that the cosmetology
21	apprentice has earned prior to the transfer to the beauty
22	culture school as one half $(1/2)$ of an hour of credit at the
23	beauty culture school.
24	(i) A cosmetology apprenticeship program approval must be
25	renewed every five (5) years with the board.".
26	Page 4, between lines 5 and 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:
27	"SECTION 1. IC 25-8-6-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.170-2013,
28	SECTION 41, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
29	JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 3. (a) The application described in section 2 of
30	this chapter must state that the applicant:
31	(1) is at least eighteen (18) years of age;
32	(2) has graduated from high school or received the equivalent of
33	a high school education;
34	(3) holds a cosmetologist, an electrologist, a manicurist, a barber,
35	or an esthetician license issued under this article;
36	(4) has completed the education and experience requirements,
37	subject to subsection (b) and the rules adopted by the board;
38	(5) has not committed an act for which the applicant could be

disciplined under IC 25-8-14;
(6) has received a satisfactory grade (as described in IC 25-8-4-9)
on an examination for instructor license applicants prescribed by
the board; and
(7) has paid the fee set forth in IC 25-8-13-4 for the issuance of a
license under this chapter.
(b) In addition to the requirements under subsection (a) and this
chapter, an applicant for a cosmetologist instructor license must
state that the applicant has completed at least one hundred (100)
hours of methodology.".
Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
