<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> The bill provides that an individual who completes a United States Department of Labor registered apprenticeship program to practice cosmetology may take the cosmetologist licensure examination and, upon passage of the examination, practice as a cosmetologist.

Effective Date: July 1, 2024.
