## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

Your Committee on <u>Education</u>, to which was referred <u>House Bill 1137</u>, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new 2 paragraph and insert: 3 "SECTION 1. IC 20-19-3-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE 4 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE 5 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 32. (a) As used in this section, "civics based 6 reading instruction materials" means reading instruction materials 7 for kindergarten through grade 3 that concern educational 8 concepts of United States history and civics. 9 (b) The department shall develop methods to provide parents, 10 students, educators, and schools with affordable civics based 11 reading instruction materials.". 12 Page 1, line 4, delete "notice," and insert "notice and the student 13 meets the requirements of subsection (b),". 14 Page 1, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:

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"(b) In order to be released for a purpose described in

1	subsection (a), a student enrolled in a public school must:
2	(1) not be habitually truant; and
3	(2) be in academic good standing.".
4	Page 1, line 9, strike "(b)" and insert "(c)".
5	Page 1, line 10, after "(a)," insert "if the student meets the
6	requirements described in subsection (b),".
7	Page 1, line 17, strike "(c)" and insert "(d)".
8	Page 2, line 5, strike "(d)" and insert "(e)".
9	Page 2, line 9, strike "(e)" and insert "(f)".
10	Page 2, line 37, strike "(b)." and insert "(c).".
11	Page 2, after line 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:
12	"SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this
13	SECTION, "civics based reading instruction materials" has the
14	meaning set forth in IC 20-19-3-32(a), as added by this act.
15	(b) As used in this SECTION, "department" refers to the
16	department of education established by IC 20-19-3-1.
17	(c) Not later than September 1, 2024, the department shall, in
18	consultation with the Indiana civic education commission
19	established by IC 20-19-10-2 and the Indiana Bar Foundation, do
20	the following:
21	(1) Identify:
22	(A) affordable civics based reading instruction materials
23	for use by parents, students, educators, and schools;
24	(B) methods to encourage the further development of civics
25	based reading instruction materials for use as curricular
26	materials; and
27	(C) incentives, including grants and tax credits, for the
28	adoption and use of civics based reading instruction
29	materials in public schools and charter schools.
30	(2) Establish recommendations for the general assembly
31	related to the creation of a state civic seal program to
32	recognize excellence in civic education among students,
33	educators, and schools, including the following:
34	(A) Awarding of civic seals, including public recognition
35	and financial awards.
36	(B) Potential sources for funding of financial awards
37	described in clause (A), including charitable contributions
38	that are eligible for partial tax credits.

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1	(3) Report to the general assembly, in an electronic format
2	under IC 5-14-6, the:
3	(A) information identified under subdivision (1); and
4	(B) recommendations established under subdivision (2).
5	(d) This SECTION expires October 1, 2024.
6	SECTION 4. An emergency is declared for this act.".
7	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
