



COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Pensions and Labor, to which was referred House Bill No. 1153, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 12, delete lines 34 through 42.
- 2 Page 13, delete lines 1 through 35, begin a new line block indented
- 3 and insert:
- 4 **"(5) With respect to injuries occurring on and after July 1,**
- 5 **2022, and before July 1, 2023, for each degree of permanent**
- 6 **impairment from one (1) to ten (10), one thousand eight**
- 7 **hundred three dollars (\$1,803) per degree; for each degree of**
- 8 **permanent impairment from eleven (11) to thirty-five (35),**
- 9 **two thousand eleven dollars (\$2,011) per degree; for each**
- 10 **degree of permanent impairment from thirty-six (36) to fifty**
- 11 **(50), three thousand two hundred eighty-two dollars (\$3,282)**
- 12 **per degree; for each degree of permanent impairment above**
- 13 **fifty (50), four thousand one hundred eighty-two dollars**

- 15 **(6) With respect to injuries occurring on and after July 1,**
- 16 **2023, and before July 1, 2024, for each degree of permanent**

- 19 **degree of permanent impairment from eleven (11) to**
- 20 **thirty-five (35), two thousand seventy-one dollars (\$2,071) per**

 10 of permanent impairment from eleven (11) to thirty-five (35),
 11 two thousand one hundred thirty-three dollars (\$2,133) per
 12 degree; for each degree of permanent impairment from
 13 thirty-six (36) to fifty (50), three thousand four hundred
 14 eighty-one dollars (\$3,481) per degree; for each degree of
 15 permanent impairment above fifty (50), four thousand four
 16 hundred thirty-six dollars (\$4,436) per degree.

17 (8) With respect to injuries occurring on and after July 1,
 18 2025, for each degree of permanent impairment from one (1)
 19 to ten (10), one thousand nine hundred seventy dollars
 20 (\$1,970) per degree; for each degree of permanent
 21 impairment from eleven (11) to thirty-five (35), two thousand
 22 one hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$2,197) per degree; for
 23 each degree of permanent impairment from thirty-six (36) to
 24 fifty (50), three thousand five hundred eighty-five dollars
 25 (\$3,585) per degree; for each degree of permanent
 26 impairment above fifty (50), four thousand five hundred
 27 sixty-nine dollars (\$4,569) per degree."

28 Page 14, delete lines 35 through 42, begin a new line block indented
 29 and insert:

23 Page 21, delete lines 1 through 8, begin a new line block indented
24 and insert:

27 **dollars (\$402,000).**

28 **(6) With respect to an injury occurring on and after July 1,**
29 **2023, and before July 1, 2024, four hundred fourteen**
30 **thousand dollars (\$414,000).**

31 **(7) With respect to an injury occurring on and after July 1,**
32 **2024, and before July 1, 2025, four hundred twenty-six**
33 **thousand dollars (\$426,000).**

35 **2025, four hundred thirty-nine thousand dollars (\$439,000)."**

 26 thirty-six (36) to fifty (50), three thousand four hundred
 27 eighty-one dollars (\$3,481) per degree; for each degree of
 28 permanent impairment above fifty (50), four thousand four
 29 hundred thirty-six dollars (\$4,436) per degree.

30 (8) With respect to disablements occurring on and after July
 31 1, 2025, for each degree of permanent impairment from one
 32 (1) to ten (10), one thousand nine hundred seventy dollars
 33 (\$1,970) per degree; for each degree of permanent
 34 impairment from eleven (11) to thirty-five (35), two thousand
 35 one hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$2,197) per degree; for
 36 each degree of permanent impairment from thirty-six (36) to
 37 fifty (50), three thousand five hundred eighty-five dollars
 38 (\$3,585) per degree; for each degree of permanent
 39 impairment above fifty (50), four thousand five hundred
 40 sixty-nine dollars (\$4,569) per degree."

41 Page 48, delete lines 23 through 33, begin a new line block indented
 42 and insert:

18 **(B) not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75);**

 20 **1, 2023, and before July 1, 2024:**

21 **(A) not more than one thousand two hundred forty-one**
 22 **dollars (\$1,241); and**

23 **(B) not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75);**

24 **(7) with respect to disablements occurring on and after July**
 25 **1, 2024, and before July 1, 2025:**

26 **(A) not more than one thousand two hundred seventy-eight**
 27 **dollars (\$1,278); and**

28 **(B) not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75); and**

29 **(8) with respect to disablements occurring on and after July**

34 Page 56, delete lines 1 through 4.

35 Page 58, delete lines 12 through 23, begin a new line block indented
 36 and insert:

37 **"(5) With respect to disability or death occurring on and after**
 38 **July 1, 2022, and before July 1, 2023, four hundred two**
 39 **thousand dollars (\$402,000).**

40 **(6) With respect to disability or death occurring on and after**
 41 **July 1, 2023, and before July 1, 2024, four hundred fourteen**
 42 **thousand dollars (\$414,000).**

- 1 **(7) With respect to disability or death occurring on and after**
- 2 **July 1, 2024, and before July 1, 2025, four hundred twenty-six**
- 3 **thousand dollars (\$426,000).**
- 4 **(8) With respect to disability or death occurring on and after**
- 5 **July 1, 2025, four hundred thirty-nine thousand dollars**
- 6 **(\$439,000)."**
