

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Corrections and Criminal Law, to which was referred House Bill No. 1200, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

1	Page 4, line 17, after "who" insert "knows or reasonably should
2	know that an individual is a human trafficking victim and who".
3	Page 4, line 22, strike "for a" and insert "for the".
4	Page 4, line 22, strike "by a" and insert "by the".
5	Page 4, line 24, after "if" insert "the person knows or reasonably
6	should know that".
7	Page 4, delete lines 26 through 29, begin a new paragraph and
8	insert:
9	"(b) It is not a defense to a prosecution under this section that
10	the human trafficking victim consented.".
