

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Corrections and Criminal Law, to which was referred House Bill No. 1235, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

1	Page 3, delete lines 9 through 13, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"(c) This section does not prohibit a political subdivision from
3	bringing an action against a firearm or ammunition manufacturer,
4	seller, or dealer:
5	(1) alleging the breach of a contract or warranty as it relates
6	to a firearm or ammunition purchased by the political
7	subdivision; or
8	(2) to enforce a generally applicable zoning or business
9	ordinance that applies to a firearm or ammunition
10	manufacturer, seller, or dealer to the same degree as other
11	similar businesses.".
	(Reference is to HB 1235 as printed January 18, 2024.)
