Summary of Legislation: The bill raises the total amount of food that a public school or school corporation may purchase from a youth agricultural education program to \$10,000 per fiscal year. It specifies that if a purchasing agency purchases more than \$10,000 of food from a youth agricultural educational program per fiscal year, the purchasing agency must comply with the applicable federal procurement requirements.
