1412 , has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

- 5 Page 6, line 5, delete "and".
- Page 6, line 5, strike "a local" and insert "an appropriate".
- Page 6, line 5, delete "in Indiana".
- 8 Page 6, delete lines 13 through 42, begin a new paragraph and

3	individual required to make a report under this article in the
4	individual's capacity as a member of the staff of a hospital licensed
5	under IC 16-21-2 is subject to section 2.5 of this chapter.
6	(b) (a) If an individual is required to make a report under this article
7	in the individual's capacity as a member of the staff of a medical or
8	other public or private institution, school, facility, organization, or
9	agency, the individual shall immediately make a report to:
10	(1) the department; or
11	(2) the local appropriate law enforcement agency.
12	The individual does not have discretion to decide not to report
13	known or suspected child abuse or neglect, unless a report has
14	already been made and documented by the individual in charge
15	under subsection (d).
16	(b) An individual required to make a report of known or
17	suspected child abuse or neglect may not delegate the duty to make
18	the report to another individual, unless:
19	(1) the individual to whom the duty is being delegated is part
20	of the child's care team and has personally been involved in
21	the child's care; and
22	(2) the notification of suspected child abuse or neglect made
23	to the individual described in subdivision (1) is in writing.
24	(c) The individual described in subsection (b)(1) shall
25	immediately report the suspected child abuse or neglect to the
26	appropriate law enforcement agency or the department. As soon
27	as possible after making the report to law enforcement or the
28	department, the individual described in subsection (b)(1) shall do
29	the following:
30	(1) Record in writing that they were notified of suspected
31	child abuse or neglect, including the identity of the person
32	who notified them, the date and time that they received the
33	notification, and the date and time that they reported the
34	suspected child abuse or neglect to law enforcement or the
35	department of child services.

(2) Place or cause to be placed in the child's medical file:

(A) the details included in the report to law enforcement or

the department of child services, including the date and

2	(B) the condition of the child at the time the report was
3	made, if known; and
4	(C) any other relevant and necessary information.
5	(d) After making the report, the individual required to make the
6	report and the individual described in subsection (b)(1) shall notify
7	the individual in charge of the institution, school, facility,
8	organization, or agency or the designated agent of the individual in
9	charge of the institution, school, facility, organization, or agency that
10	the report was made.".
