Your Committee on <u>Commerce, Small Business and Economic Development</u>, to which was referred <u>House Bill 1521</u>, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

1 Page 8, after line 24, begin a new paragraph and insert: 2 "SECTION 2. IC 35-45-19-1.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.47-2019, 3 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE 4 JULY 1, 2025]: Sec. 1.5. As used in this chapter, "human remains" 5 means any part of the body of a deceased human being: 6 **(1)** in any: 7 (A) stage of decomposition; or 8 (B) state of preservation; or 9 (2) that indicate unique deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA). 10 SECTION 3. IC 35-45-19-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.47-2019, 11 SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

1	JULY 1, 2025]: Sec. 3. A person who:
2	(1) observes, discovers, or handles human remains when it
3	appears the deceased person died:
4	(A) by violence, suicide, or accident;
5	(B) suddenly, while in apparent good health;
6	(C) while unattended;
7	(D) from poisoning or an overdose of drugs;
8	(E) as the result of a disease that may constitute a threat to
9	public health;
10	(F) as the result of:
11	(i) a disease;
12	(ii) an injury;
13	(iii) a toxic effect; or
14	(iv) unusual exertion;
15	incurred within the scope of the deceased person's
16	employment;
17	(G) due to sudden infant death syndrome;
18	(H) as the result of a diagnostic or therapeutic procedure; or
19	(I) under any other suspicious or unusual circumstances; and
20	(2) knowingly or intentionally fails to report the observation,
21	discovery, or handling of the human remains to a:
22	(A) public safety officer;
23	(B) coroner;
24	(C) funeral director;
25	(D) physician; or
26	(E) 911 telephone call center;
27	within three (3) hours after finding the human remains;
28	commits failure to report the observation, discovery, or handling of
29	human remains, a Class A misdemeanor.".
