## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

## MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on Education , to which was referred House Bill 1553 , has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new 2
- paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 21-12-13-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.81-2019,
- 4 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 2. (a) This section applies to the following
- 6 scholarship, stipend, and fee remission statutes:
- 7 (1) IC 21-12-3.
- 8 (2) IC 21-12-4.
- 9 (3) IC 21-12-6.
- 10 (4) IC 21-13-2.
- 11 (5) IC 21-13-7.
- 12 (6) IC 21-13-8.
- 13 (7) IC 21-13-4.

3	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c), and except for a stipend
4	granted under IC 21-13-8 to an individual described in
5	IC 21-13-8-1(b)(2)(B), a grant or reduction in tuition or fees, including
6	all renewals and extensions, under any of the laws listed in subsection
7	(a) may not exceed the number of terms that constitutes:
8	(1) except as provided in subdivision (2), four (4) undergraduate
9	academic years, as determined by the commission; or
10	(2) for purposes of IC 21-13-4, six (6) academic years as
11	determined by the commission;
12	and must be used within eight (8) years after the date the individual
13	first applies and becomes eligible for benefits under the applicable law.
14	(c) The commission may, subject to the availability of funds, extend
15	eligibility under subsection (b) for a recipient who used a grant or
16	reduction in tuition or fees under any of the statutes listed in subsection
17	(a) at a postsecondary educational institution that closed. The extension
18	of eligibility may not exceed the number of terms used by the recipient
19	at the postsecondary educational institution that closed.".
20	Page 1, line 16, delete "3.75" and insert "3.5".
21	Page 2, after line 32, begin a new paragraph and insert:
22	"SECTION 3. IC 21-13-1-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007, SECTION
23	254, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
24	1, 2021]: Sec. 4. "Eligible student", for purposes of section 8 of this
25	chapter, means a person who:
26	(1) is a member of the Indiana National Guard:
27	(A) in active drilling status; and
28	(B) who has not been absent without leave within the twelve
29	(12) months immediately preceding the date the person applies
30	for a tuition scholarship under this chapter;
31	(2) does not possess a bachelor's degree from an approved
32	postsecondary educational institution;
33	(3) (2) possesses the requisite academic qualifications;
34	(4) (3) meets the requirements of the state educational institution
35	in which the person is enrolled or will enroll; and
36	(5) (4) meets all other eligibility requirements as determined by
37	the commission.

2	1, 2021]: Sec. 2. Money in the National Guard tuition supplement
3	program fund shall be used to provide annual scholarships to
4	scholarship applicants in an amount that is equal to one (1) of the
5	following amounts:
6	(1) If the scholarship applicant does not receive other financial
7	assistance specifically designated for educational costs, the
8	amount equal to a full undergraduate tuition scholarship,
9	regardless as to whether the student uses the scholarship for
10	undergraduate or graduate educational costs, to attend the
11	state educational institution.
12	(2) If the scholarship applicant receives other financial assistance
13	specifically designated for educational costs, the amount:
14	(A) equal to the balance required to attend the state
15	educational institution; and
16	(B) not to exceed the amount described in subdivision (1).
17	SECTION 5. IC 21-13-4-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.217-2015,
18	SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
19	JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 3. (a) Subject to subsection (b), each scholarship
20	awarded under this chapter:
21	(1) may be renewed under this chapter for a total scholarship
22	award that does not exceed the equivalent of the number of terms
23	that constitutes four (4) undergraduate six (6) academic years as
24	determined by the commission; and
25	(2) is subject to other eligibility criteria as established by the
26	commission.
27	(b) A scholarship awarded under this chapter may not be renewed
28	if the eligible individual fails to maintain at least a cumulative grade

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- 1 point average that the eligible institution determines is satisfactory
- 2 academic progress.".
- Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively. (Reference is to HB 1553 as introduced.)
