<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> The bill extends the Indiana Women's Suffrage Centennial Commission (IWSCC) until July 1, 2024. It requires the IWSCC to commission the creation of a suitable monument to the people of Indiana active in the women's suffrage movement and the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States. It requires the Department of Administration to install the monument commissioned by the IWSCC on the grounds of the State House before January 1, 2024.

**Effective Date:** Upon passage.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The bill extends the IWSCC until July 1, 2024, and requires the IWSCC to commission the creation of a suitable monument to the people of Indiana active in the women's suffrage movement and the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States. The bill does not make an appropriation for the monument. It requires the Department of Administration to install the monument on the grounds of the State House before January 1, 2024, which could minimally increase their workload.
