COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 70, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

1	Delete the title and insert the following:
2	A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
3	criminal law and procedure.
4	Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the
5	following:
6	SECTION 1. IC 5-2-25 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
7	A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
8	1, 2024]:
9	Chapter 25. Bail and Release Review Commission
10	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" means the bail
11	and release review commission established by section 2 of this
12	chapter.
13	Sec. 2. The bail and release review commission is established
14	as a temporary executive branch commission to do the following:
15	(1) Review data concerning the effect of bail reform
16	measures on public safety, including violent crime and
17	recidivism.
18	(2) Review data concerning the effectiveness of pretrial
19	release measures in ensuring a defendant's court
20	appearance.
21	(3) Review data concerning the effectiveness of pretrial
22	release reform efforts in Indiana.
23	(4) Review the effect of pretrial detention on defendants.
24	(5) Review bail schedules and practices used statewide.
25	(6) Review the effectiveness of bail and release measures
26	used in other states.

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1	(7) Before November 1 of each year, issue a report
2	containing its findings and recommendations to:
3	(A) the governor; and
4	(B) the legislative council.
5	The report to the legislative council must be in an electronic
6	format under IC 5-14-6.
7	Sec. 3. The commission consists of the following eighteen (18)
8	members:
9	(1) The president pro tempore of the senate, or a designee of
10	the president pro tempore who is a member of the senate.
11	The president pro tempore or designee shall serve as a
12	co-chairperson of the commission.
13	(2) The minority leader of the senate or a designee of the
14	minority leader who is a member of the senate.
15	(3) The speaker of the house of representatives or the
16	speaker's designee who is a member of the house of
17	representatives. The speaker or designee shall serve as a
18	co-chairperson of the commission.
19	(4) The minority leader of the house of representatives or the
20	minority leader's designee who is a member of the house of
21	representatives.
22	(5) The governor or the governor's designee.
23	(6) The superintendent of the state police department or the
24	superintendent's designee.
25	(7) The commissioner of the Indiana department of
26	correction or the commissioner's designee.
27	(8) The director of the division of mental health and
28	addiction of the office of the secretary of the family and
29	social services administration or the director's designee.
30	(9) The budget director or the budget director's designee.
31	(10) The chief justice of Indiana or the chief justice's
32	designee.
33	(11) The president of the Indiana judges association or the
34	president's designee.
35	(12) The executive director of the Indiana prosecuting
36	attorneys council or the executive director's designee.
37	(13) A victim advocate from a prosecuting attorney's office,
38	appointed by the executive director of the Indiana
39	prosecuting attorneys council.
40	(14) The executive director of the Indiana public defender
41	council or the executive director's designee.
42	(15) The president of the Indiana sheriffs' association or the
43	president's designee.
44	(16) The executive director of the association of Indiana
45	counties or the executive director's designee.
46	Sec. 4. A member serves for a term that ends on June 30 of the
47	next odd-numbered year following the member's appointment.
48	However, the member may be reappointed to subsequent terms.
49	Sec. 5. A member who is not an ex officio member serves at the
50	pleasure of the appointing authority.
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1	Sec. 6. An appointment to thi a vacancy snall be made in the
2	same manner that an original appointment is made. An individual
3	appointed to fill a vacancy serves for the remainder of the term of
4	the former member.
5	Sec. 7. Each member of the commission who is a state
6	employee is entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses as
7	provided under IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred
8	in connection with the member's duties as provided in the state
9	policies and procedures established by the Indiana department of
10	administration and approved by the budget agency.
11	Sec. 8. Each member of the commission who is not a state
12	employee is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and
13	travel allowances paid to individuals who serve as legislative and
14	lay members, respectively, of interim study committees established
15	by the legislative council.
16	Sec. 9. Each member of the council who is a member of the
17	general assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage,
18	and travel allowances paid to legislative members of interim study
19	committees established by the legislative council. Per diem,
20	mileage, and travel allowances paid under this section shall be paid
21	from appropriations made to the legislative council or the
22	legislative services agency.
23	Sec. 10. Except for expenses described in section 9 of this
24	chapter, expenses of the commission shall be paid from funds
25	appropriated to the governor.
26	Sec. 11. The commission shall hold meetings at the call of the
27	co-chairpersons.
28	Sec. 12. Ten (10) members constitute a quorum for the
29	transaction of business.
30	Sec. 13. Each member has one (1) vote.
31	Sec. 14. Action of the commission may be taken only upon the
32	affirmative votes of at least ten (10) members.
33	Sec. 15. The office of the governor shall staff the commission.
34	Sec. 16. This chapter expires June 30, 2026.
