COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 144, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

I	Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2	following:
3	SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-12-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 7. (a) Except as
5	provided in subsection subsections (b) and (c), a farm winery may
6	purchase annually a quantity of bulk wine that does not exceed the
7	greater of the following:
8	(1) Five thousand five hundred (5,500) gallons.
9	(2) Fifty percent (50%) of the quantity of wine produced by
0	fermentation by the winery during the previous year.
1	(b) This subsection applies to a farm winery that suffers a loss of
2	wine inventory due to natural or manmade disaster. If the farm winery
13	documents the inventory loss and obtains permission from the
4	commission, the winery may purchase a quantity of bulk wine not
15	greater than the sum of the following:
16	(1) The quantity of the winery's wine inventory loss.
17	(2) The quantity of bulk wine that may be purchased by the farm
18	winery annually under subsection (a).
9	(c) The limits in subsections (a) and (b) apply only to wine sold
20	directly to a consumer in Indiana. No limit is imposed on the
21	amount of bulk wine that may be used in producing wine sold
22	through a wholesaler or sold outside of Indiana.
